
## St Andrew's Psalter Lane Church Junior Church Activity Sheet 5<sup>th</sup> July 2020 - Trinity 4





This Sunday we are going to think about ideas about home. Where do we live and where does God live.




Last week we made a tent for Abraham and Sarah – they had a travelling home:
