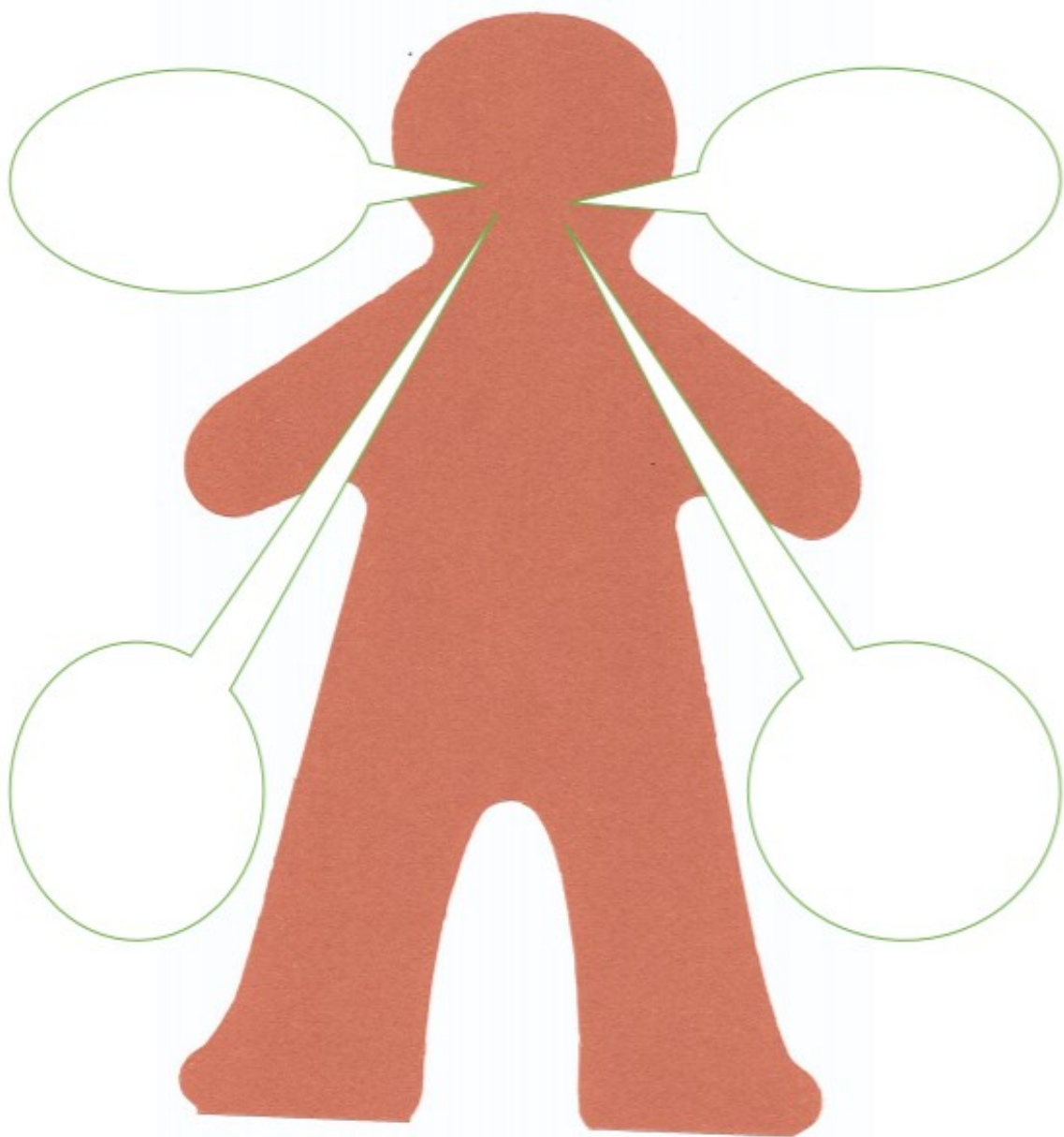


Sunday 15th November 2020 - Bags of Money!

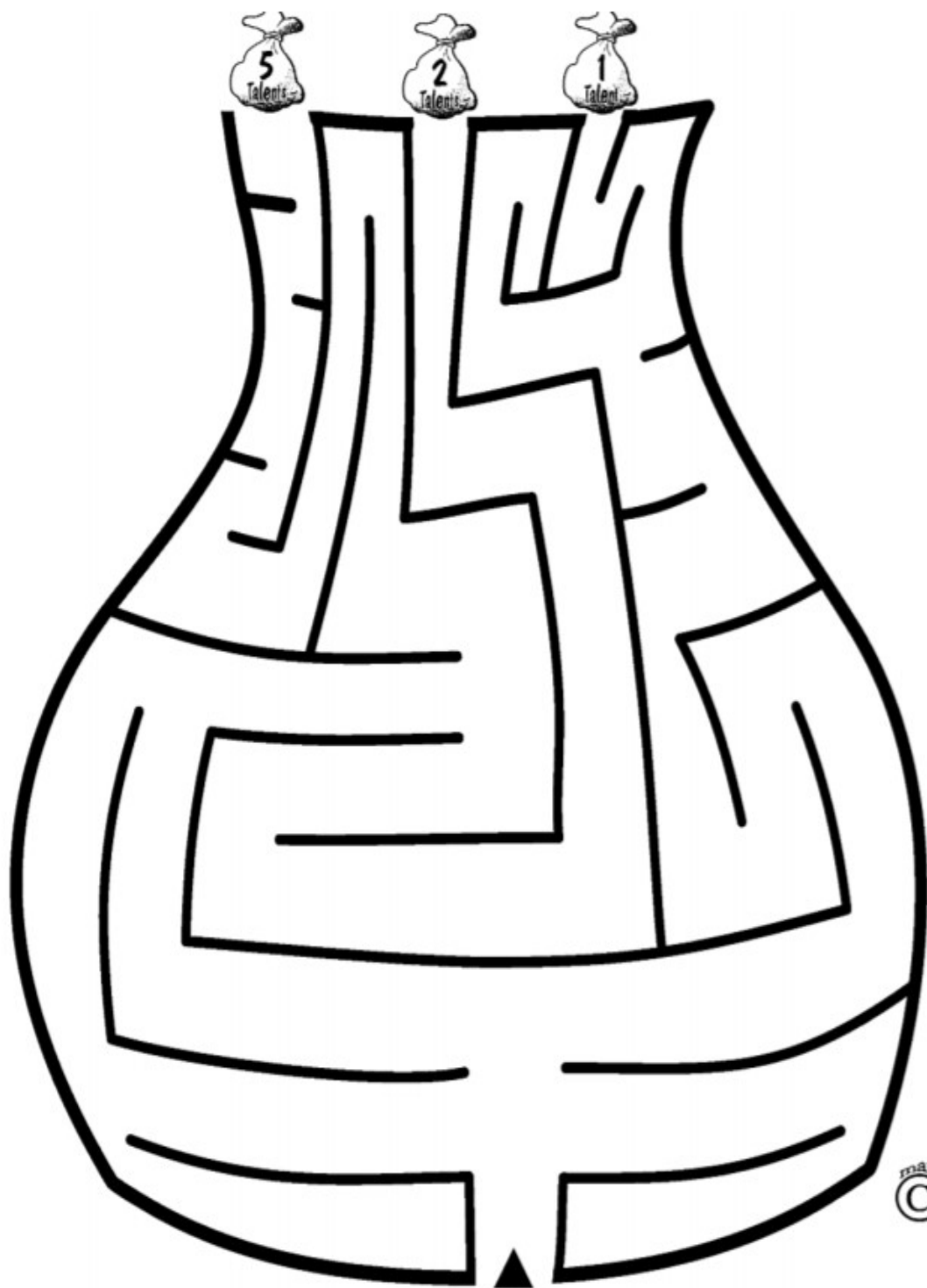
Give the figure a face and some clothes so it looks like you and put what you are good at in the speech bubbles.
